Breadth Requirement: (18 credits) Complete 120 units of coursework (Major courses, Core courses and elective courses). Out of these 120 units, six units, from at least two departments, must come from each of the three Divisions (Natural Science, Social Science and Humanities/Fine Arts). **Please note that courses taken to satisfy the CON2 requirement cannot double count in the Natural Science area.**
