

Transfer Admission Guarantee

Whittier College is offering the unique experience to local Southern Californian Community College students of attending classes at Whittier College with an average size of 19 students and a 13:1 student to teach ratio by offering the opportunity of pursuing an undergraduate education at small liberal arts college.

In past years Whittier College has maintained a mutually exclusive relationship with many of the accredited Community Colleges in the Southern California area through our Articulation Agreements. We are now proud to announce our Transfer Admission Guarantee with all accredited California Community Colleges based on the following criteria:

1. The student must submit a completed application for admission as well as all supporting documents and the application fee to Whittier College on or before the transfer application deadline.
2. The student will have completed the Freshman Writing Seminar requirement and the Quantitative Reasoning requirement with a C grade or better in each class.
3. The student will have completed at least 30 transferable units with a C- or better.
4. The student must have earned a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.8 in courses eligible for transfer. For example, if a student earned a D or below in a transferable course, that course would not be accepted for transfer credit, but would be factored into the cumulative transfer grade point average.
