

## JAN LOPEZ WOOD FELLOWSHIP IN STUDIO ARTS STUDENT CONTRACT

Dear Fellow:

To accept the Jan Lopez Wood Fellowship in Studio Arts, please review the expected deliverables and requirements detailed below. Your signature confirms acceptance of these terms and conditions.

- 1. Conduct a creative project under the guidance of a Whittier College faculty mentor.
- 2. Attend all mandatory meetings including but not limited to:
  - Weekly or biweekly meetings with your faculty mentor
  - Conference presentation (e.g. Fall Term SCCUR, URSCA, or a professional conference in your discipline. Note that conferences may require travel.)
  - Recruitment Sessions
  - Spring Scholarship and Fellowship Luncheon (when applicable)
- 3. Alert the Fellowships Coordinator to any changes in the approved fellowship project prior to proceeding with those changes.
- 4. Submit your creative project AND the conference presentation version (e.g. PowerPoint slides, poster proof) at the completion of your fellowship to the Fellowships Coordinator.
- 5. Understand you are eligible to be reimbursed up to \$1,000 for project supplies and/or travel. Expenditures must be approved in advance by your faculty mentor. Unspent supply/travel funds will be distributed to you as a stipend.
- 6. Complete the exit and mentorship experience surveys distributed by Research, Sponsored Programs & Fellowships.
- 7. Understand that upon completion of your project you will receive a \$1,000 scholarship for tuition.

Research Ethics & Safety Compliance Notice: Your project must adhere to Whittier College research ethics and safety compliance policies. If your project involves human subjects, vertebrate animals, hazardous materials, infectious agents, recombinant DNA, or genetically altered organisms, it may require institutional approval before fellowship funds can be disbursed. Please familiarize yourself in advance with the policies and procedures (website: https://www.whittier.edu/academics/researchethics). Pay special attention to compliance committee deadlines and be prepared with an alternate approach to completing the project in the event the project is not approved by the respective compliance committee.
